GENERAL ORDERS 2 – Jun 20, 2009

To be read, acted on, and filed:

1. **Membership – Cheryl Bullock: Auxiliary Treasurers** – 2009 – 2010 Early Bird Transmittals can be collected as of July 1st and sent to me as soon as possible. They must reach me no later than August 17, 2009. Mail to 21661 Bancroft Dr California City 93505. To ensure I receive it by then, please allow 5 days for me to receive it. I will take these transmittals to the Supreme Convention in August. Remember VFW dues must be paid first.
2. **Auxiliaries** - Send copies of your membership list (with contact information) as of July 1, 2009 to the Grand President, Secretary, Chaplain, Treasurer, and Hospital Chairman.
3. **Treasurer – Cheryl Bullock:** I am still in the process of reviewing all the material I received from Carol - and to add to the fun, I was out of town for awhile. As a result, the Treasurer's report for June 2009, along with the July 2009 report, will be in the next General Orders.
4. **Chaplain – LaVonne McGowan.** My report for the month of June is quite short. I received reports from four auxiliaries, and they seemed to be quite active.

5. **Email of General Orders** – Any member can receive copies of the General Orders via email. Send names & email addresses to the Grand Secretary. If anyone who is receiving the General Orders via regular USPS mail would like to receive it via email, please let the Grand Secretary know. It will save money for the Grand and you'll get the information that much faster!
6. **General Order articles:** Any Officer or Chairman can submit an article for the general Orders. Send one copy to the Secretary and one to the Grand President so she can review it before it is published. Emails are fine. Copies of all articles will be kept in a file for future reference. DEADLINE will be the 12th of the month so that it can be mailed by the 20th of each month. If urgent, email or call the President for approval.
7. **MOC / MOCA Grand Website** – The Grand of California has a great website. www.california-cooties.org. On the home page, there are links to MOCA Officers and their contact information, C of A / Convention hotel / banquet / meeting information, General Orders (which include both MOC & MOCA Orders), and MOCA Resources – which includes Membership statistics, various Forms from the Supreme Program Book, and should also have Hospital statistics this next year. Please try it out. If there is anything else you'd like to see posted, please notify the Grand President and Grand Secretary.
8. **MOC / MOCA Rosters** – will be at a cost of \$8.80 per copy. Requests are via email to grandcahq@comcast.net. If you do not have email, you can contact the Grand Secretary by mail at 1737 W Beacon Ave, Anaheim 92804 or phone (714-809-2874) and she will place order. Checks are made out to MOC Grand of California and sent to MOC Grand Quartermaster at 1417 October Way, Modesto, CA 95358.

9. The MOCA Grand will purchase combined rosters for any Officers, Chairmen, or Past Grand Presidents who wish them (per our Grand Policy). **Please let the Secretary know if you need a combined Roster.** Due to the cost, all others who don't need MOC information will receive an MOCA Auxiliary Roster only. This will be provided free to those on the Grand Policy as well as one to each Auxiliary President & Treasurer. Anyone wanting extra Auxiliary only rosters will need to send \$2.00 for printing and mailing or request a "Soft Copy" to be emailed at no cost.
10. **Supreme Program book:** All delegates registered – with delegate fees paid – for the Supreme Convention, will receive a Program Book (whether or not you actually attend the convention). The Grand will purchase books for Grand Officers and Auxiliary Presidents as needed. To help us keep the cost down, please notify the Grand Secretary if you are registered so we do not buy a second copy. Anyone wishing to purchase additional books at a cost of \$7 please contact Grand Treasurer, Cheryl Bullock. CD's of the information are also available (the cost is \$5 for the CD)
11. **Calendar 2009**
 - a. **Supreme Convention** will be **August 20 – 23, 2009** at the Arizona Biltmore Resort & Spa, Phoenix AZ. Information on the Hotel, the banquet, and registration was in last General Orders. Hotel phone # is 1-800-950-0086. Code is MOC90.
